What is Color Wars?

Different grades and classrooms across the three divisions of the school will work together on three (3) different teams, each with a designated color. Throughout the week they will compete in different competitions to earn the most points possible by the end of the school day on Friday. The winners will win a GRAND PRIZE!

Why?

Not only is this an opportunity for us to come together as a school community, but it is also a service project to benefit the **CRUDEM Foundation**.

Who is The CRUDEM Foundation ("CF")?

The CF helps manage a hospital in northern Haiti. Their important work offers much needed quality healthcare to the sick and the poor in the Haitian community. They also help operate an educational center for all who serve healthcare in Haiti.

How do I earn points?

Wardrobe: Students can wear "flair" or accessorize their uniforms with their team color Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. **Thursday** will be a dress down tag day to dress in the color of their team.

Food Collection: Throughout the week, bring in **Vitamin C lollipops** (any brand) and **high protein bars** (10g of protein or more); not only will these earn your team points but also these items will be sent to the CF in Haiti.

Penny Wars: Each team is assigned a jar to collect money – pennies earn you points, and all other coins and bills will lose points. Load your jar up with pennies and add all your other coins and bills to the other teams' jars. All proceeds will be donated to the CF.

Lunch/Gym Games: Throughout the week, students will be playing games at lunch/recess and gym to earn additional points. Games include dodgeball, basketball, tug-o-war, and trivia.

GREEN: 8th Grade, with Preschool, PreK, Kindergarten and 5th

RED: 7th Grade, with 1st and 4th

BLUE: 6th Grade, with 2nd and 3rd

Pack-a-Thon: Friday, April 28th | Grades 5-8

Together with the St. Joseph Parish, Saint Joe's students in grades 5-8 will visit the Needham Knights of Columbus hall to help pack 150,000 meals (dried beans, rice, vegetables and vitamins, sealed and packed in boxes) to send to the CRUDEM Foundation and their Sacre Coeur Hospital in Milot, Haiti, a 200-bed facility that together we have been supporting for more than 12 years.
